- Be at least 16 years old on the date of issue (authorization of the legal guardian for children under 18).
- Hold a pledge level 1 or a patent granted in equivalence.
- Have a minimum of 15 dives on the day of the patent application.
- Be in possession of a medical certificate of non-cons-indication to the practice of underwater diving established for less than 1 year.

NATURAL ENVIRONMENT

NATURAL ENVIRONMENT 1

- Go back to the compass
- Course in triangle, square or rectangle (to choose).
- Raise and tow a diver over 50 meters.
- The recording in the logbook.

NATURAL ENVIRONMENT 2

- Search and recovery of object (use of the parachute lift)
- On 500 m, travel by snorkel breathing.

NATURAL ENVIRONMENT 3

- Diving at night or at poor visibility
- Go down in full water, with diving suit, on a bottom of 15 to 20 m.

NATURAL ENVIRONMENT 4

- Deep dive at 30 meters maximum.
- Maintenance of a bearing without other marks than personal instruments.
- Use of the landing gear
